




Overview: Archway Platform core modules.



- 30+ Dashboard Inserts

Why use Dashboard Inserts?

- Summary level information at Enterprise and Entity level
- Drill-through capabilities for further insights
- Tailored for quick view of information






Reporting suite: Archway Client Portal.

What is the Archway Client Portal?

- Interactive, mobile reporting tool to deliver consolidated wealth information to family members and outside stakeholders
- Acts an extension of the Archway Platform's traditional reporting capabilities
- Allows users to customize the client's online reporting experience through dashboards and interactive charts, graphs, and tables

Why use the Archway Client Portal?

- Provides secure, digital access to financial reporting and other relevant documents
- Engage next gen of wealth owners
- Tailored to end clients (non-Platform users) for information consumption and approval's, e.g. Bill Pay Workflow
- Deliver consolidated holdings and allocation detail, account value and net worth, performance with benchmarks, cash activity and balance details, and expense and spending summaries






Reporting suite: Customizable on-screen data grids.

What is Data Grid Customization?

- Data Grid customization allows for greater control over the format and data points being displayed
- Columns can be re-ordered
- Customization tool allows for additional columns to be added or existing columns to be removed

Why use it?

 Customized data grid layouts can be output to Excel allowing for user-defined system extracts






Reporting suite: Raw data queries.

What are Queries?

- Unformatted data extracts in Excel
- Types of Queries
 - General Data Queries (Open Positions, GL Activity, Private Equity Details)
 - Setup Queries (Accounts Payable, Class Assignments, User Access)
 - Audit Queries (General Ledger, Portfolio Transactions, Security Classification)
 - Support Queries (Nested Out of Balance, Nested Close Order)

Why use Queries?

- Favorite Queries
- Query Batches
- Can be utilized in conjunction with X-File Import Templates (setup, classifications, etc.)






Reporting suite: The Archway Platform's standard report library.

What is the standard report library?

- 200+ reports available out-of-the-box
- Report Type will group reports into categories within the report list
- Customizable with ability to include client logo and customized footers
- Reports can be found at Entity Menu → Reports


Definitions: Report parameters and common terms.

1. Date Range

- Beginning and Ending time period or As Of dates
- You will notice different date selections:
 - Drop down: Typically depicts that these reports require the accounting period to be closed: Performance reports
 - Free-form: Typically means this report can be run for the open accounting period, typically as long as a UEP has been run

2. Alt Report Name/Title/Custom Report Name

- Name: Change the name on the actual report output (top upper right hand name)
- Title: Some reports allow for dual names in a report, this is under the custom name (e.g. Client Allocation Summary)
- Custom Report Name: Change the name of a report in the table of contents (exclusive to Batching & Scheduling)





Definitions: Report parameters and common terms.


3. Grouping Level

- At what level do you want to run the report- options are by Profile, Entity, Portfolio as well as the given classes
- So why would I want to run a report by say a Profile (and select each profile) vs. a Profile Class?

4. Asset Grouping Levels (1 & 2)

- Security Class or Security Type
- This is how the data is actually displayed on reports (typical examples- grouping 1: Broad Asset Class, grouping 2: Detailed Asset Class)
- 1 & 2 can be the same selection- this will collapse the selection

5. Exclude Other Assets





Definitions: Report parameters and common terms.

Additional parameters:

- Display Details
 - If selected will show exposure down to the security level
 - Rolled up to the chosen Security Class Option(s) if not
- Return Calculations
 - Time Weighted
 - Money Weighted
 - Gross vs. Net vs. Both
- Exclusions



Definitions: Report scope.

Reports in the Archway Platform can be generated for a single Entity, across multiple Entities, for a single Investor or for an entire class of Investors. The determination of what information is displayed is driven by the scope selection on the parameter screen.


Any report containing a tab labeled 'Scope' can be generated for multiple Investors, Entities or Portfolios. Statements - Client Account Summary Basics Scope Collapse Portfolios Date Range 07/01/2022 to 07/31/2022

Certain Entity level reports will display an 'Entity' tab allowing for the selection of multiple Entities. • Think financial statements: Balance Sheet, Income Statement, etc. Balance Sheet Basics Entity Code Block As of 06/30/2022

Active entity (no Scope / Entity tabs)

If a report does not contain a Scope or Entity tab that means the report can only be generated for the Entity that it is active.

- Some Entity-specific reports also have an Enterprise version (ex: Open Positions (Enterprise))
- Queries can be utilized for cross-Enterprise reporting when a report does not exist





Definitions: Classes.

What are classes in the Archway Platform?

- User-defined grouping mechanisms that allow for clients to categorize reporting
- Unlimited flexibility in regards to type and number of classes
- Each class has corresponding options that then can be assigned for reporting, filtering, etc.

Class type	Example	Options
Entity	Type of Entity	Partnerships, Trusts, Family Members, Operating Companies
Portfolio	Manager	Smith, Jones, Phillips
Security Class	Sector	Healthcare, Technology, Financial Services
Profile Class	Family	Roberts Family, Young Family
Account Class	Collapsed Balance Sheet	Cash, Investment, Receivables, Payables




Definitions: Report groupings.

What are Grouping Levels in the Archway Platform?

- Grouping determines how information is organized on a report.
- Asset Level Grouping is a common report parameter found on Security level reports that allows for multi-level classifications of Securities on the report output.







Definitions: Nested look-through.

What is nesting?

• In the Archway Platform, nesting refers to a relationship between two Entities in which one Entity is owned by another Entity.


How is nesting configured?

• In the Partnership Entity there will be an Equity account that represents the Partner's investment in the Partnership. On the Partner Entity, there will be a Portfolio to reflect the nested investment in the Partnership.

How does nesting work?

• Let's look at an example...







Definitions: Nested look-through.

Master:

• Will display all investments held directly by the Entity being reported on, no visibility into indirect holdings.

Feeder with Look Through Nested Entities selected:


• Full holdings visibility, from owner through partnership entities to underlying positions. Direct and indirect investments displayed.

Feeder with Look Through Nested Entities un-selected:

 Will display investments held directly and display nested equity value as a single line item.

Segregate Nested P/L:

 Recent Enhancement to be able to breakout nested P/L balances by entity.
















Reporting examples: Expense management reporting capabilities.






Reporting examples: Expense management reporting capabilities.
